



BE Mentor / Team Leader

The role:

- You will be committed to heading up a team of 4 students, forging positive relationships with each team member to support their personal and academic development.
- You will be available every Saturday during term between 9am – 1pm or 2pm to offer in class support for teacher/students.
- You will be familiar with the lesson focus/learning content and feedback observations of aspects of the service.
- You will deliver a keynote speech in morning assembly on something they are passionate about or a particular theme that promotes aspiration once a term.
- You will meet with each student every fortnight in person or via skype for a one hour mentoring session aided by the discussion/reflection points set out in the mentoring handbook (x2 one hour sessions per week).
- Once a term you will be on hand to facilitate extended extra-curricular activities, assisting on trips, team building, social action projects, awards ceremonies, etc.

Requirements:

- You must be passionate about social justice and empathetic to the challenges faced by disadvantaged learners.
- You must have a strong academic track record.
- You must have strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- You must have excellent time-keeping and organisational skills.
